

Rules & Regulations

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) deadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The Rose Mount Farm Horse Show is recognized by USEF, VHSA, and MHSA. Any questions or disputes which arise that are not specifically provided for shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.

While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication the USEF, Rose Mount Farm, and its management and/or employees assume no liability for errors.

The Committee reserves the right to postpone, reschedule, combine, or cancel any class or classes if in its judgement the entries are inadequate, for reasons of inclement weather or dangerous conditions or for any other reasons it deems necessary.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of courtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any persons from attending or

showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation. No person will be allowed in the shrings during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those who have official or requested duties to perform.

Neither the Committee and horse show employees nor Rose Mount Farm and its owner and employees, will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, groom, attendant, animal or equipment at the show.

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Sharps containers will be provided at the barns, exhibitors are responsible for properly disposing of waste or risk incurring up to \$100 in fines.

Dogs must be on leashes while on Show Grounds, owners who fail to comply may be subject to fines, seizure of the animal, and/or additional penalties.

Protective, approved headgear with a properly secured chin strap must be worn at all times while mounted anywhere on the Show Grounds.

Rules & Regulations (cont'd.)

Ticketed schooling will be permitted Tuesday in Ring I and Wednesday in Ring II. Flatwork only in Ring III. for \$25/round. Ticketed Schooling may be offered after show days at managements discretion, no other schooling over fences permitted. Flatwork only on show mornings, rings will close one hour before scheduled start times. Ring I: 150'x 300'; Ring II: 120'x 250'; Ring III: 135'x 290'. All rings including warmup and lunging are all weather footing.

196 permanent 10'x 10' stalls with doors and stall mats and 100 permanent 10'x10' stalls with doors and dirt floors are available on grounds. Stall fees must accompany entry blanks. Stalls will be assigned on a first come basis, specific stabling requests will be considered but will not be guaranteed. Additional tent stabling will be available if entries warrant.

Stall fees will be \$225/week. Management reserves the right to use stalls more than once. Ship ins are permitted and will pay a \$50 grounds fee. Non Showing horses are permitted but must complete and sign an entry blank and provide a valid Coggins. A \$100 non showing horse fee will apply.

No initial bedding will be provided. To order feed and bedding prior to the start of the show please call Robert Wheeler at 540-847-6212.

A limited number of camper spaces (30 amp electrical hookups only) are available for \$125.

Closing date is July 11, 2025. Entries must be secured by a valid credit card number or an open check (separate from stall fees) made payable to Rose Mount Farm. All entries will be responsible for a \$50 (non refundable) office fee, any entry received after the closing date will also be subject to a \$35 late fee.

Online entries will be accepted via horseshowsonline.com, however an entry will not be considered as entered in the horse show until a valid credit card number is provided or a completed check for stall fees and an open check to secure the account has been received.

Adds and scratches should be submitted to the show office or online by 4pm the day prior. No same day adds will be permitted (if entries warrant management may waive this restriction), same day scratches accepted with no penalty.

Non negotiable checks will incur an additional \$50 fee. Unpaid entries will be forwarded to USEF per GR913.

Social security information must be provided for any animal entered in classes with prize money. Prize money will be credited to show accounts, any prize money overages will be mailed to the payee listed on the entry blank within 30 days of check out. **2024 offered \$18,150 2024 Guaranteed \$5,000 2023 Offered \$18,550 2023 Paid \$11,787.50.**

Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Every horse entered in classes must pay the \$15 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus and \$8 USEF Fee. Every horse must also pay the USHJA Fee of \$7.

Rules & Regulations (cont'd.)

Exhibitors should be prepared to show valid USEF/USHJA credentials for themselves and their horses. Any horse or pony not possessing a valid measurement card must be measured by the show steward prior to competing in their respective division. Exhibitors who cannot produce verification of membership must purchase a USEF Show Pass directly through USEF or purchase an active membership and complete SafeSport training as applicable. A \$30 USHJA Show Pass can be purchased through the horse show for inactive members. Parents signing as trainer for their child must meet membership requirements listed above. Refer to USEF.com for microchip requirements.

Show scratches will be accepted with a veterinarian's certificate, however stall and office fees are non refundable.

Virginia State law requires each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year, a copy of which must be submitted to the show office. The Virginia State Veterinarian's Office will be spot checking for health papers, Coggins and vaccinations, be sure to have your paperwork available. **Exhibitors are encouraged to submit their Coggins with entry blanks to expedite check in.**

Per USEF GR845 proof of vaccination for EHV and Equine Influenza within six months of the competition must also accompany each entry. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the grounds upon request. Per USEF rules all horses and ponies must have a valid microchip number on file with USEF in order to compete.

Reminder:

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Prize Money: Prize Money: All prize money reflects per class payouts, for both over fences and under saddles.

Conformation Sections: To be judged 70% on performance, 30% on conformation. Model class ½ points.

Jogging: For all divisions that require a jog - horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

Ribbons: 1-8 unless otherwise specified.

Qualify by winning any of the Zone 3 state equitation medals, including the VHSA Junior and Children's Medal, NCHJA Children's Medal, EJ Haun Memorial Medal, MHSAA Hunt Seat Medal Horse, Gittings Horsemanship Medal, etc. or by winning any national equitation class in any state or zone between July 16, 2023 and July 15th, 2024.

The class will be divided into two height sections: 3' and 3'6". However, the two height sections will be judged as one class.

The 3' section is limited to riders who have not competed three or more times in any class or division at 3'6" or higher.

The course shall consist of at least ten fences with at least one combination and two changes of direction. The top 12 will return for a flat phase. A minimum of the top 4 riders will return for further testing. A numerical scoring system will be used. The Uptown Award shall be awarded by the judges to the Horse most suited to the class.
