



Rules & Regulations

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current federation rule book and current FEI rules will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

2026 USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and Jr. active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR407.1-3) For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$25 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding used of medications and drugs & \$10 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay a \$10 USHJA Fee and a USHJA Show pass \$30 fee will be collected for any person who is not a current USHJA member.

The Rose Mount Farm Horse Show is recognized by USEF, VHSA, and MHSA. Any questions or disputes which arise that are not specifically provided for shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final. While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication the USEF, Rose Mount Farm, and its management and/or employees assume no liability for errors. The Committee reserves the right to postpone, reschedule, combine, or cancel any class or classes if in its judgement the entries are inadequate, for reasons of inclement weather or dangerous conditions or for any other reasons it deems necessary.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall

disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any persons from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation. No person will be allowed in the show rings during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those who have official or requested duties to perform.

Neither the Committee and horse show employees nor Rose Mount Farm and its owner and employees will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, groom, attendant, animal or equipment at the show. Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or legal guardian.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Electronic Devices: The unsafe use of electronic devices, as determined by the competition steward in their sole discretion, including cell phones, while mounted is prohibited in all areas designated for schooling and exercise, and while lunging horses on competition grounds. Earphone(s)/Earbud(s) are prohibited in areas designated for schooling and exercise.

Sharps containers will be provided at the barns. Exhibitors are responsible for properly disposing of waste or risk incurring up to \$100 in fines.

DOGS: Per USEF Rule GR1301.6 **Dogs must be on leashes** while on Show Grounds. Owners who fail to comply may be subject to fines, seizure of the animal, and/or additional penalties.

HEAD GEAR: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear in compliance with the accepted testing standards published on the Federation's website. Protective headgear must carry the applicable quality testing tag and/or label. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

SCHOOLING, WARMUP, LUNGEING: USEF RULE HJ106.c.d.e.: All horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its assigned show number attached to the horse or the individual riding or handling. All horses in the exercise area must have its assigned show number attached to the horse or the individual exercising. All horses being lunged in the designated lunging area, or anywhere else on show grounds, must have its assigned show number attached to the horse or the individual lunging. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area.

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS: To be eligible to compete at Federation Licensed Competitions, coaches, trainers, and legal guardians signing as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing, as defined herein. All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification, and measurement cards for Small Jr. Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. See Show Office for Measurement Times.

USEF SHOW PASS FEE: Effective 12-1-2022 any rider, handler, driver, or owner are limited to one USEF Show Pass purchase annually (December 1- November 30). USEF Show Pass will be available for purchase by exhibitors online only. USEF Membership will be required in order to compete for anyone who has not purchased a Show Pass through their USEF portal. Trainers and Coaches are no longer eligible to participate under a Show Pass and must be an Active USEF member. Parents signing as trainer for their child must meet membership requirements listed above.

SAFE SPORT TRAINING: As of January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training. Failure to complete the Safe Sport training will disqualify you from competing in any capacity until it is completed. Jr. riders that have reached their 18th birthday must complete Safe Sport training.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More Information can be found at www.usef.org.

HORSE IDENTIFICATION AND RECORDING (GR1101): All horses competing in Federation licensed competitions must be properly identified. For all such competitions, entries for each horse must include either a Federation-issued Unique Horse Identification Number or a registration number from a Federation Recognized Affiliate. USHJA Horse Registrations. All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA (exception: opportunity, academy, exhibition, walk-trot and lead line). A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms. Visit www.ushja.org.

MICROCHIPPING: All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions. Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

HORSE/PONY HEALTH PAPERWORK: Virginia State law requires each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year of competition, a copy of which must be submitted to the show office. The Virginia State Veterinarian's Office will be spot checking for health papers, Coggins and vaccinations, be sure to have your paperwork available. Per USEF GR845 proof of vaccination for EHV and Equine Influenza within six months of the competition must also accompany each entry. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the grounds upon request.

Please submit your health documents with entry to expedite check-in.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: Championships shall be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points over fences. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the Under Saddle classes and half points for ribbons won in Model. Points awarded for all divisions as follows: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. Ties in USEF Hunter Championships shall be decided as specified in the USEF Rule Book.

PRIZE MONEY: An IRS W9 needs to be completed showing the proper prize money recipient and their SSN or Fed ID #. Prize money will be deducted from your account upon closeout in the office provided you have submitted the required W9 or W8 for Foreign exhibitors. Balances will be paid by check and mailed to the named recipient on the W9 within 30 days after the conclusion of the show.

ENTRIES: Closing Date is March 30, 2026. Entries must be secured by an open check (separate from stall fees) payable to Rose Mount Farm or a valid Credit Card. All entries will be responsible for a \$50 non-refundable Office Fee. Entries received after the Closing Date will incur a \$35 Late Fee. Online Entries will be accepted via horseshowsonline.com, however an entry will not be considered as entered in the horse show until a valid credit card number is provided (or a completed check for stall fees and an open check to secure the account has been received). **REFUNDS:** Stall and Office fee are non-refundable

PAYMENT METHOD: Show Fees may be paid by cash, check or any major credit card (3% fee).

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: Checks returned by the bank, declined credit cards or chargebacks on credit card transactions will incur an additional \$50 fee. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full or they will be reported to USEF.

TICKETED SCHOOLING (\$25/round) will be available in Rings I & II from 9am-4pm on Tuesday; in Ring III Thursday from 1pm-4pm. Assigned Show Numbers must be worn. No schooling permitted after conclusion of show on show days. Flatwork only on show mornings, rings will close 1 hour before scheduled start times.

Ring I: 150'x300'; Ring II: 120'x250'; Ring III: 135'x290'

All rings including warmup and lunging areas are all weather footing.

STALLS: 196 permanent 10'x10' stalls with doors and dirt floors are available on grounds. Stall Fees must accompany Entry Forms. Stalls will be assigned on a first-come basis. Specific stabling requests will be considered but no guaranteed. Additional tent stabling will be available if entries warrant. No initial bedding will be provided.

Stall Fees will be \$225/week. Management reserves the right to use stalls more than once. Stall Fees are non-refundable.

FEED AND BEDDING: To order feed and bedding prior to the start of the show, please call Robert Wheeler at 540-847-6212

SHIP-INS are permitted and will pay a \$50 Grounds Fee.

NON-SHOWING HORSES are permitted but must complete and sign an entry blank and provide a valid Coggins. A \$100 Non-Showing Horse Fee will apply.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT RISKS: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equine activities, including but not limited to horseback riding and equestrian sport, are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under VA Code Ann. Sec 3.2-6200-6203, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the “Released Parties” or “Event Organizers”**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature (“**Liability**”) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time. Further, by signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in USEF Events. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR907.4. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice.
